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**91.3 WYEP Calls for Applications from Area Teen Musicians**  
Reimagination recording project to launch in January

**Pittsburgh, Pa.—Oct. 7, 2015:** WYEP's Reimagine Media has announced a call for applications for its 2016 Reimagination recording project. Teen musicians aged 12-19 from Southwestern Pennsylvania can apply to be part of the Reimagination CD.

This will be the third CD produced through Reimagine Media, an initiative of WYEP's Education Department that connects young area musicians with a team of professional musicians who mentor them through the process of creating, recording, and producing a full-length CD.

Applications will be accepted until midnight November 1, 2015; all applications will be reviewed, and those selected to participate in the project will be notified in mid-November.

Those selected to participate in the 2016 Reimagination CD project will work with professional producers and will receive studio time to record and produce a song for inclusion on the compilation CD, released by WYEP. They will be mentored through the processes of recording, mixing and mastering the CD at The Church Recording Studio. This year for the first time, WYEP and Point Park University's Sports, Arts and Entertainment Management Department will work in partnership to offer educational workshops for the selected Reimagination Project musicians and producers.

Reimagine Media is also accepting proposals for cover and packaging artwork for the Reimagination CD. Interested artists can submit via the application form online.
