Party And Silent Auction To Benefit WYEP

Pittsburgh, Pa. —September 10, 2014: The Backstage Bash, a celebration of 91.3 WYEP's 40th Anniversary, will take place on Thursday, November 6, 2014 at the Renaissance Pittsburgh Hotel. Tickets to the event are on sale at wyep.org/backstagebash.

The Backstage Bash will feature acoustic performances by Pittsburgh musicians **Bill Deasy**, **Scott Blasey**, **The Wreckids**, and **Jessica Bitsura**, as well as a silent auction benefitting WYEP that includes unique experiences such as house concerts, signed music memorabilia, and works of art. Guests will enjoy fine wine and food, with carving stations and hot and cold hors d'oeuvres throughout the event. The top ticket to The Backstage Bash includes admission to the 8:00 p.m. concert by **Trombone Shorty and Orleans Avenue** at the Byham Theatre, co-presented by WYEP and The Pittsburgh Cultural Trust.
